## **Guidelines, Benefits, and Obligations for Virtual Professional Groups**

## i. Guidelines on Participation in a Virtual Professional Group

- 1. Interested faculty must submit an application to the MIIIE Director.
- 2. Selected faculty will be assigned to a Virtual Professional Group (VPG).
- 3. The members of a VPG will organize the schedule and participate in the presentations and discussions based on selected books or articles.
- 4. Faculty will be invited to submit a "Call for Proposals" to the MIIE Director to present and facilitate discussions on a significant book or article.
- 5. A VPG Committee will review the "Call for Proposals" and select presenters-facilitators, while the MIIE Director will organize the program.

## ii. Benefits provided by the Midwest Institute and NRC partners

- 1. \$300 stipends for selected presenters-facilitators.
- 2. Free registration for the VPG members.
- 3. Professional development and shared collegiality for the participants.

## iii. Obligations by the Faculty

- 1. VPG members must participate in the scheduled programming.
- 2. VPG members are working at a college member of the Midwest Institute consortium.
