

Guidelines, and Selection Criteria for Development of Curriculum Modules

on a Geographic Region or Country

Based on available funding and sponsorship by NRCs, the MIIIE Director will invite interested faculty to submit an application to develop a curriculum module on a geographical region or country based on the five sections described below.

An MIIE-NRC Selection Committee will review, grade, and select applicants. During the module development the faculty will receive feedback on their module drafts and must complete (with approval) their modules based on a timetable.

- 1. Provide a <u>brief description</u> of the curriculum module you like to develop. Important: Indicate which geographic region or country the module will cover. (30 points)
- 2. Provide specific <u>curriculum objectives</u> your module will achieve. (20 points)
- 3. Provide a listing of the <u>resources</u> to be used for your module. (15 points)
- 4. Indicate what <u>assessment tools</u> will be used to measure curriculum objectives. (15 points)
- 5. Describe how your curriculum module will <u>benefit your students</u>' international education. (20 points)
