Objectives and Potential Impact:

Goals: a) Increase enrollment of students through recruitment activities and by providing different cultural experiences. b) Provide additional study opportunities increasing the number of students who study abroad. C) Increase International and Intercultural professional development opportunities for both faculty and staff. Development will take place through on-campus events, study travel, and other programs.

Objective 2: To provide a more pervasive, consistent, and up-to-date global perspective through STLCC-FP's academic programs and co-curricular activities.

Goals: a) We will increase intercultural programming, including foreign language offerings by one percent during the course of the four-year project. We have had global/intercultural programming calendars in the past. b) Grow support for global awareness events and programs on campus.

Objective 3: To gather, analyze, and report data on elements of the international and intercultural initiatives plan that will provide information the effectiveness of the programs.

Goals: a) Develop mechanisms for tracking student progress following participation in international and intercultural programs, especially study and service learning abroad experiences. The goal is to increase the number of study abroad experiences by one percent during the course of the four-year project. b) Develop mechanisms for measuring impact of globalization programs on faculty and staff participation in International/Intercultural programs, especially professional development experiences.
