i. Guidelines on Participation

1. The faculty must fill-out and process a registration (see registration forms for free or \$25 registration).
2. During the workshops, the faculty participants will receive materials and participate in academic discussions.
3. Participating faculty could be invited to submit an application to develop a curriculum module and receive a stipend.

ii. Benefits provided by the Midwest Institute & NRC partners

1. \$1,000 stipends will be provided to selected faculty for participating in a workshop, for developing a curriculum module, and for making a 20-30 minutes presentation regarding the module at the 2022 or 2023 MIIIE conference.
2. Curriculum materials, access to electronic resources, and support will be provided during and after the workshop.

iii. Obligations by the Faculty and/or his/her College

1. Free or \$25 registration fee (see choices of registration forms).
2. Selected faculty could develop a curriculum module.
3. Faculty must do a presentation on her/his module at the 2022 or 2023 MIIIE conference.
4. Faculty is teaching at a college member of the Midwest Institute consortium.
