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i. **Guidelines on Participation**

- 1. The faculty must fill-out and process a registration (see registration forms for free or \$25 registration).
- 2. During the workshops, the faculty participants will receive materials and participate in academic discussions.
- Participating faculty could be invited to submit an application to develop a curriculum module and receive a stipend.

ii. Benefits provided by the Midwest Institute & NRC partners

- 1. \$1,000 stipends will be provided to selected faculty for participating in a workshop, for developing a curriculum module, and for making a 20-30 minutes presentation regarding the module at the 2022 or 2023 MIIIE conference.
- 2. Curriculum materials, access to electronic resources, and support will be provided during and after the workshop.

iii. Obligations by the Faculty and/or his/her College

- 1. Free or \$25 registration fee (see choices of registration forms).
- 2. Selected faculty could develop a curriculum module.
- 3. Faculty must do a presentation on her/his module at the 2022 or 2023 MIIIE conference.
- 4. Faculty is teaching at a college member of the Midwest Institute consortium.
