APPLICATION, GUIDELINES & SELECTION CRITERIA Development of Curriculum Modules

Only faculty participating in MIIIE workshops are eligible to submit an application to develop a curriculum module based on the five criteria-sections described below.

MIIIE will review, grade, and notify the applicants. During the module development the faculty will receive feedback on their module drafts and must complete (with approval) their modules by December 31, 2024.

- 1. Provide a <u>brief description</u> of the curriculum module you like to develop. Important: Indicate which geographic region (e.g., Africa, Latin America, or Middle East) the module will cover. (30 points)
- 2. Indicate the <u>course</u> to be infused by the module and specific <u>curriculum</u> objectives your module will achieve. (20 points)
- 3. Provide a preliminary listing of the <u>resources</u> to be used for your module. (15 points)
- 4. Indicate what <u>assessment tools</u> will be used to measure curriculum objectives. (15 points)
- 5. Describe how your curriculum module will <u>benefit your students</u>' international education. (20 points)
- 6. Applicants who will be "first-time" developers of a curriculum module sponsored via the Midwest Institute will be given 7 priority points.
